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Exhibitors

- Event registration booth will be open:
 - Friday, September 20th from 3-8pm
 - Saturday, September 21th from 6am-8:30am
 - Sunday, September 22nd from 6am-8:30am
- Booth spaces are first come- first served basis
- Final tear-down can begin on Sunday after 4:00pm (We ask that you do not tear down early, but also that you be off the grounds by 7pm to avoid extra fees)
- All exhibitors agree to load and unload in the designated area during the times specified above
- Exhibitors must supply their own tents, tables, chair and all needed display equipment
- Tents must be weighted down or staked. Tents with sides provide protection and are recommended in case of inclement weather- the event is rain or shine
- Festival helpers will be on hand to aid with some unloading
- Generators are permitted – however, please advise us before installing them.
- Exhibitors parking tag must be displayed to park in the designated area
- Overnight parking (no services) will be permitted
- There will be handicapped parking spaces available

Friday Evening Events

- Set up can begin at 3pm following registration
- Dish-to-Pass Dinner for all vendors and event team members to begin around 6pm. You are invited to join in the fun. Please bring a dish to pass. We will have some hot dogs and fixings along with some plates, napkins and plastic silverware. We will also have water available.

Security

- Seven Generations of Stewards, Native Nations Festival staff, all event sponsors, volunteers, and security at the event are not responsible for any loss, damaged, stolen personal or exhibitor inventory items including booth and displays while attending the event
